The Vessel Manager Education is a part time education that takes 1,5 years. The education consists of 6 modules. Each module can be taken separately and all modules are completed with an exam. The education is at diploma level.

Mode of Attendance

Candidates are required to attend all modules. The dates for the modules are planned in advance in order to provide the candidates adequate time and flexibility to plan for attendance.

Programme Entrance Requirements

A candidate shall satisfy the Admission Requirements as listed below:

1. Comply with the General Regulations at the Copenhagen School of Marine Engineering and Technology Management.

2. Hold a Bachelor's degree or a qualification of equivalent standard from Denmark or another comparable institution accepted for this purpose.
3. Have minimum 2 years work experience.
4. For qualification from a university or comparable institution outside Denmark where the language of teaching and/or examination is not English, candidates should already have a basic foundation and familiarity with reading and writing in English. The main focus is on discussion of texts, group activities, debate, and presentations. It is also a requirement that the candidate produces written assignments. The required Common European Frame of Reference level is B1.
5. Comply with the allocated study load time, 7-11 hours pr. Week.
6. Satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination, if required.
